

The Hive Enrichment Program: During COVID-19

- Program cap is 35 students
- Families will receive monthly statements and pay monthly or weekly.
(see Covid-19 pricing sheet)
- The Hive at both sites will open at 6:45 am daily and close at 6:00 pm daily
- The Hive on-site at BES will operate:
Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday
6:45 am - 8:45 am
4:00 pm - 6:00 pm
- The Hive off-site (CHS) will operate:
Monday-Friday
6:45 am - 6:00 pm
12:00 - 1:00
center cleaning/sanitization & student transportation
- On Wednesdays, The Hive off-site (CHS) will be open from 6:45 am - 6:00 pm for
both Group A & Group B
6:45 am - 6:00 pm.

Each 2 hour period will include:

- 40 minutes of indoor free play with personal toys
- 20 minutes of snack time (provided by The Hive)
- 30-40 minutes of homework, educational worksheets, reading, and/or remote learning screen time
- 20 minutes of read aloud
- 15 minutes of flex/transition time (bathroom breaks, clean up, etc.)

Each 5 hour period will include:

Duration of rotating groups / Full day Wednesdays

- 60 minutes of indoor free play with personal toys
- 60 minutes of homework, educational worksheets, reading, and/or remote learning screentime
- 20 minutes of read aloud
- 20 minutes of snack time (provided by The Hive)
- 30+ minutes of crafts, Art activity, STEM activity, etc.
- 60 minutes (2 sessions, 30/minutes each) of outside play or indoor small group games (w/ social distancing considered)
- 20-30 minutes personal screen time on designated days/ personal home toys

- 20-30 minutes of flex/transition time (bathroom breaks, clean up, dismissal prep. etc.)

Each child will:

- Have a basket/bin with their name on it to store their personal items while at The Hive. If they attend both AM & PM they will need to have a basket at each location.
**All personal items must be labeled with names and must be transported in personal carrier/bag in order to prevent lost or damaged items.
- Have center activities/games that will be rotated and sanitized daily, provided for each set group.

- Have a supply pouch, provided by The Hive, containing the following items to be used to make crafts/art projects
 - Crayons
 - Markers
 - Colored pencils
 - Glue stick
 - Pencil and eraser
 - Scissors

Additional considerations:

- We will provide our current flex pay option to parents at an “as needed” basis.
- We will have the following discounts and additional charges:
 - *10% discount for siblings (i.e. 10% reduction off additional sibling tuition)
- There will be a \$35 one time registration fee for new Hive families.
- An additional \$15 monthly supply fee for all Hive families, per child for the duration of the COVID program.
- Our current offsite location will be Christiansburg High School.
- 12:00-1:00 will be our daily cleaning periods as shown as gap times above.
- Every child is **required to wear a mask** for the entirety of their time in the program. Make sure masks have their names on it as we are not responsible for lost items. Please be sure to pack a spare mask in their backpacks as they are easily misplaced.
- If you decide to pull your child out for unforeseen reason, please put in writing and make sure that is given to the program director *one week prior* to ending the program.
